Description of Service	We offer ESL classes in two distinct programs: English for Academic Success (EFAS) and English for Success (EFS). The EFAS program is a 14-week program designed to prepare students for university studies where the language of instruction is English. There is also a 6-week condensed summer EFAS program. The EFS program is a 4-week summer program of intensive English classes. There are 4 levels of classes offered in both the EFAS and EFS programs: low-intermediate, intermediate, high-intermediate and advanced. Who is service designed for? Who is eligible?	The minimum age to join the EFAS and EFS programs is 17. The EFAS program is designed for students wishing to pursue university studies in English, while the EFS program is designed to help improve general spoken and written English proficiency. However, both programs are open to anyone wishing to improve their English language skills. We accept university students as well as community members.
